Both Musk Thistle and Scotch Thistle are invasive biennial plants that are a threat to the agricultural and ecological health of Crook and Grant County. This noxious weed is easily controlled when treated in a timely fashion, from April to mid-July (before plants have bolted).

CRWMA and SFJDWC provides landowner assistance in dealing with musk or scotch thistle. This can include plant identification, determining treatment options, and providing herbicide.
